# CHILDREN'S TIME "Spring cleaning"

#### **SCRIPTURE READING** St. John 2:13-22 (GNB New Testament, page 118)

It was almost time for the Passover Festival, so Jesus went to Jerusalem. <sup>14</sup> There in the Temple he found people selling cattle, sheep, and pigeons, and also the moneychangers sitting at their tables. <sup>15</sup> So he made a whip from cords and drove all the animals out of the Temple, both the sheep and the cattle; he overturned the tables of the moneychangers and scattered their coins; <sup>16</sup> and he ordered those who sold the pigeons, "Take them out of here! Stop making my Father's house a marketplace!" <sup>17</sup> His disciples remembered that the scripture says, "My devotion to your house, O God, burns in me like a fire."

<sup>18</sup> The Jewish authorities came back at him with a question, "What miracle can you perform to show us that you have the right to do this?"

<sup>19</sup> Jesus answered, "Tear down this Temple, and in three days I will build it again."

<sup>20</sup> "Are you going to build it again in three days?" they asked him. "It has taken forty-six years to build this Temple!"

<sup>21</sup> But the temple Jesus was speaking about was his body. <sup>22</sup> So when he was raised from death, his disciples remembered that he had said this, and they believed the scripture and what Jesus had said.




