WELCOME & OPENING RESPONSES based on Psalm 98

(responses in bold-face italics)

Sing a new song to the LORD who has done wonderful things! **Sing praises to the LORD!**

HYMN *Praise the Lord with the sound of trumpet* (Church Hymnary 169)

1 Praise the Lord with the sound of trumpet, praise the Lord with the harp and lute, praise the Lord with the gentle sounding flute.

Praise the Lord in the field and forest, praise the Lord in the city square, praise the Lord anytime and anywhere. Praise the Lord in the wind and sunshine, praise the Lord in the dark of night, praise the Lord in the rain or snow or in the morning light.

Praise the Lord in the deepest valley, praise the Lord on the highest hill, praise the Lord; never let your voice be still.

Praise the Lord with the clashing cymbal, praise the Lord with the pipe and string, praise the Lord with the joyful songs you sing. Praise the Lord on a weekday morning, praise the Lord on a Sunday noon, praise the Lord by the light of sun and moon. Praise the Lord in the time of sorrow, praise the Lord in the time of joy, praise the Lord every moment; nothing let your praise destroy. Praise the Lord in the peace and quiet, praise the Lord in your work or play, praise the Lord everywhere in every way!

OPENING PRAYER (A prayer from India, Aruna Gnanadason)

When everything around seems to be collapsing into injustice and chaos Creator God, teach us to love you and to recognize that you hold the earth gently in your hands. When we do not know just what to do and where to turn, teach us to trust your wisdom, so that we can discern your presence in events around us. When we become unforgiving and vindictive, teach us to grasp your tenderness, and forgive us for all we do wrong. When violence, fear and hatred seem to overtake us, teach us to receive your compassion, and steer our lives in the ways of justice and peace. When we think we can go it alone, teach us to depend on your grace, so that with patience and persistence we can transform the world. But most of all, teach us to appreciate your goodness, for in you we have new life! Amen.

SCRIPTURE READING John 15:9-17 (GNB New Testament, page 138)

"I love you just as the Father loves me; remain in my love. ¹⁰ If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have obeyed my Father's commands and remain in his love.

HYMN / BLESSING / POSTLUDE Shalom, shalom (Church Hymnary 208)


Shalom, shalom, peace to his people, shalom, shalom, the grace of God be with you, now and for ever.


